Ten school teams, each comprised three students and a teacher, researched and planned their own study focuses and itineraries and realized them in a 14-day trip through several German cities between July 14 and 28, 2013. Over 100,000 visitors had logged on during this fortnight to share their experience in culture, science, music, childhood education and organic lifestyle of Germany.

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
